Taxi Service from O'Hare and Midway

Taxi service is the easiest and most direct way to get to Loyola University, Chicago, Water Tower Campus.

Chicago Taxi Rates <http://chicago.taxiwiz.com/fare.php?lang=en> (January 2013)

Initial Charge	\$2.25
Rate per Mile	\$1.80
Rate per minute stopped or in traffic	\$0.33
Surcharge for trips to airports	\$1.00

Expect to pay at least \$38 (up to \$50) plus tip from the airports to Loyola.

"GO Airport Express offers shared ride airport shuttle service, private van service, and airport limousine service between Chicago O'Hare and Midway Airports and your home, office, hotel, convention center or school."

It operates 7 days a week/365 days a year. It leaves every 15 minutes. Reservations are recommended. Use website.

From O'Hare Airport

One way for 1 person to Loyola: \$32

Round trip for 1 person to & from Loyola: \$58

Pick up is outside each terminal.

If a reservation has not been made, a ticket can be purchased at Terminal 1E

From Midway Airport

One way for 1 person to Loyola: \$27

Round trip for 1 person to & from Loyola: \$48

Pick up is at Door 3. Tickets can also be purchased at Door 3.

If using public transportation, it is safer to travel with someone else and to travel during the day.

International travelers will be arriving at Terminal 5, The International Terminal.

Take the O'Hare rail system to the transportation center which is located behind the Hilton Hotel across from Terminal 2. Look for CTA signs

Purchase a ticket: ask for a transfer for the bus. (cost is around \$2.00)


Take the **M** Blue Line toward Forest Park


Penultimate stop (next to last stop) is Division


Exit the 'L' at Chicago Ave.

(Trip should be about 36 minutes, 14 stops)

If you are arriving late at night, consider taking a cab from this point.

 Walk to Chicago Ave and Milwaukee: Stop ID 561
(1 minute walk, 8 minutes to make transfer)

 Take Bus 66 toward Navy Pier (east)
Penultimate stop (next to last stop): Chicago & State (Red 'L' Line)
(13 minutes, 13 stops)

 Exit Chicago Ave & Wabash: Stop ID 578
Head east on E Chicago Ave toward N Wabash Ave (36 feet)
Turn left onto N Wabash Ave (308 feet)
Turn left onto E Pearson St. (115 Feet)
Arrive at 25 E. Pearson St., Chicago, IL 60611(conference)/26 E. Pearson, Chicago, IL 60611 (housing)
(2 minute walk)

Total Travel Time: 59 minutes

26 E. Pearson, Baumhart Hall, Water Tower Campus, Loyola University, Chicago (conference housing)

 Look for signs directing you to the **M** Orange Line
Exit the airport and walk south along S. Cicero Ave./Route 50 (.3miles)
Turn left on W 59th Street (.2 miles)

Follow the curve to the Orange Line
(about a 11 minute walk)

Take the **M** Orange Line toward the Loop
(21 mins, 7 stops)
Penultimate stop (next to the last stop): Halsted Street-Orange
Exit the Orange Line at Roosevelt

Transfer to the **M** Red Line toward Howard
(9 mins, 6 stops)
Penultimate stop (next to the last stop): Grand Avenue-Red Line
Exit at Chicago Ave-Red Line

 Walk to 25/26 E Pearson Street, Chicago, IL 60611
(About 2 minutes, 492 ft)
Head north on N State Street toward W Pearson Street (240 feet)
Turn right onto E Pearson Street (253 feet)

Car Parking

The water tower campus does not have a parking facility, but there are many public lots available. Rates are high. See <http://luc.edu/parking/watertower.shtml>.

A less expensive option would be to park at the Lake Shore Campus for \$7.00 per day in the P1 Parking Garage. (See Map of Lake Shore Campus) Loyola University Chicago's Lake Shore Campus is located at 1032 W. Sheridan Road, Chicago The Lake Shore Campus is 7-8 miles north of the Water Tower Campus.

Drive your car to the P1 Parking Garage and make arrangements for overnight parking at the office in the garage. The transportation office is open from Monday to Friday from 7am to 8 pm and on Saturday from 7 am to 12 (noon). You need to explain the event you are attending and that you need to leave your car overnight. **YOU MUST SPEAK TO GARAGE PERSONNEL TO MAKE ARRANGEMENT TO LEAVE YOUR CAR OVERNIGHT.**
